**\* School Spirit Gear will be available on our website starting in July and will feature “Pride Lions” t-shirts, sweatshirts, sweat pants and shorts.**

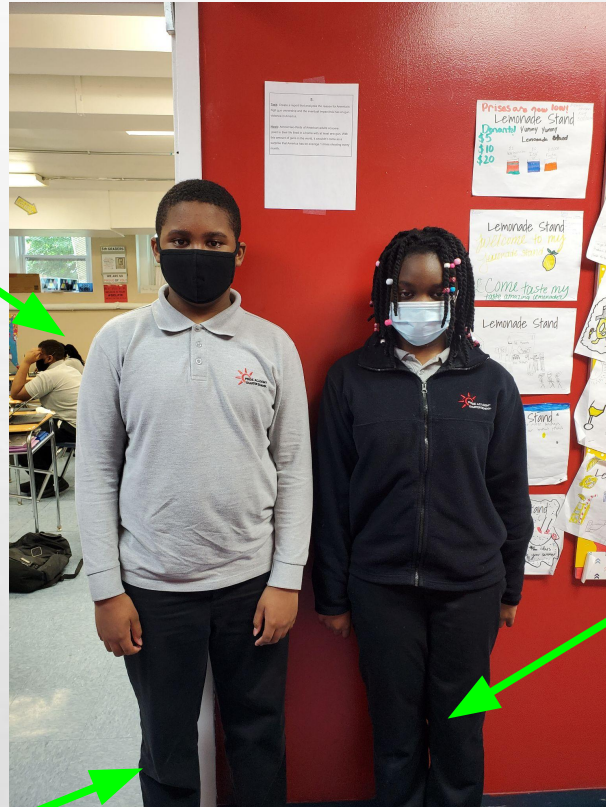

# PRIDE Dress Uniform

**Pride Uniform Polo Shirt  
from Uniform Shop**



**Black belts are optional,  
unless needed to hold up  
pants.**

**ANY Black  
DRESS Pants**

- *Pants no longer have to be from the Uniform Shop. - They can be any black dress pants, but they must be DRESS PANTS.*
- *NO jeans, jeggings, leggings, overly tight or skinny pants are permitted.*

**Solid Black Shoes or Any Color Sneakers**

- *Sneakers no longer have to be predominantly black.*
- *NO high heels, slides, Crocs, Uggs, platforms, wedges, or open-backed shoes are permitted. **Socks of any color may be worn on any day.***

## PLEASE NOTE:

No hoop or dangling earrings are permitted due to safety concerns on gym days and during recess time.

**Gym Uniform T-Shirt must have a Pride logo and purchased from The Uniform Shop @ Kids Place OR they must be authorized Pride Spirit Gear given as testing prizes and incentives.**

**Starting in July, families will also be able to purchase Pride Spirit Gear through an online store that will be posted on our website.**

# PRIDE Gym Uniform



- \* ANY SOLID BLACK knee length basketball style shorts.**
- \* ANY SOLID BLACK sweatpants or joggers.**
- \* They do not need to have the school logo or purchased from the Uniform Shop.**
- \* They MUST BE SOLID BLACK No colored logos, stripes or swooshes are allowed on sweatpants or shorts.**

**Any color sneakers and any color socks may be worn on gym days.**

# PRIDE Uniform

## Sweaters, Sweatshirts & Fleeces

- Only authorized Pride sweatshirts, sweaters, or fleeces may be worn as part of the Pride uniform.

- **NO HOODIES OF ANY KIND MAY BE WORN IN SCHOOL.**

This includes Pride hoodies that were sold prior to 2022, when Pride Academy stopped selling hoodies.



Pride uniform polo or t-shirts must be worn under the Pride sweaters, sweatshirts, and fleeces.

# PRIDE ACADEMY UNIFORM SWEATERS, SWEATSHIRTS & FLEECES

- Families are strongly encouraged to ensure that their children always have a Pride uniform sweater, sweatshirts, and fleeces **even during warm weather months**, because our rooms are air conditioned, which may feel cold to some scholars.
- Scholars are responsible for keeping their uniform items with them at all times and not losing them.
- **FAMILIES SHOULD LABEL ALL PRIDE UNIFORM ITEMS SO THEY CAN BE EASILY IDENTIFIED IF THEY ARE LOST OR MISPLACED.**



# Accessories

---

- Rings and hoop earrings are not permitted.
- Earrings must be no bigger than one inch.
- Some jewelry including bracelets, watches and necklaces may be worn, but scholars should be mindful of their care and safety.
- Scholars may be asked to remove jewelry if the jewelry is noisy, distracting or poses a safety hazard during gym, recess, or class.
- No visible tattoos





# Hair & Headwear

**Middle-school aged children are incredibly concerned about their appearance and how they are perceived by their peers, which often impacts their ability to focus on their learning. Their hair is a big part of that.**

**We respectfully ask parents to support their children by helping them be properly groomed and ready for a professional, academic setting.**

- Cultural headwraps and kufis may be worn.
- No oversized hair ornaments (eg: flowers, bows, etc)
- No bonnets, scarves, bandanas, hairnets, durags, hats, caps, or similar attire is permitted with the uniform.



# Dress Code for Dress Down Days



- Scholars may not wear clothing with offensive language or images.
- No skirts or dresses unless it's part of a professional dress or theme dress down day that a long dress or skirt would be appropriate.
- No mini skirts or mini skorts
- Uniform Skirts/skorts or shorts must be NO MORE than 3 inches above knees
- No dangling earrings or hoop earrings during recess or gym.
- NO ripped or frayed jeans **where the skin is exposed.**
- **Students must wear appropriate undergarments.**
- NO clothing that reveals undergarments or exposes the buttocks, back, cleavage, chest, belly, hips, upper thighs, or abdomen.
- **NO EXTREMELY SKINNY OR TIGHT PANTS or LEGGINGS.**
- No spaghetti strap tops, tank tops, leggings, sandals, flip flops, open-toe shoes, CROCS or heels are allowed.
- No extremely loose sagging jeans may be worn.
